Welcome and Call to Order Yvonne Bryant

Vice President's Update & Celebrations Valarie Kadera

The Yearbook has sold very well. Dr. Thompson has approved for the PTSA to manage it next year. It will need to be a club next year. We will need a teacher sponsor for the club. The Senior awards went very well also.

School of Excellence Lauren Van Hemert

Lauren reported we got 30 responses to the surveys. The National PTSA will review the surveys and submits a report. Lauren was able to go through the report. But it wasn't complete yet. We are judged on 6 pillars of Family Engagement.

Principle's Report Dr. Ashlie Thompson

Dr. Thompson announced that she was being promoted to Area Superintendent. There was a brief discussion on what that meant for our school.

She reported there are 100 incoming freshmen in the Fall.

Meet the teacher date was changing to a teacher work day. It is open to all students.

Treasurer's Update April Jackson

April reported that for this school year the PTSA spent \$1003.07 on the students. For the teachers the PTSA spent \$513.31. On general operating expenses the PTSA spent \$1873.00. The current balance of the checking account is \$1415.66 with \$47.11 in pending expenses.

The Block Party was budgeted for \$150 but the PTSA incurred no expenses. The Holiday luncheon was budgeted for \$150 but the expenses were 100% donated.

Board Nominations Aletha Chrietzberg & April Jackson

Heide Rumble was nominated to Treasurer position. She is the only nomination to the either the Secretary or Treasurer's position. Heide stated she only wanted to serve a 1 year term. She was formally nominated and voted in as the new Treasurer. Since there were no

nominations for Secretary Aletha agreed to serve until a secretary could be voted in at first PTSA meeting. She has served her 2 year term and therefore cannot continue as secretary.

Committee Updates

Fundraising Donta Jackson

Donta stated she absolutely needs more help from the Juniors & Seniors. And from parents also.

There are still Krispy Kreme coupons. It was decided to go ahead to try and sell them. She is also planning to have something at Meet the Teacher to sell.

Celebrations Valerie Kadera
